Forklift Seats - A seat is a strong, strong surface to be seated, normally raised above floor level. A stool is a seat which does not have a back or any arm rests. A seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is known as a recliner, whereas a seat together with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has attached wheels, it can be known as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is referred to as a swing. A permanently connected seat in a theatre or a train is referred to as a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type found inside automobiles and an infant car seat will be a seat particularly designed for young kids.

The design of the seat could differ quite considerably to accommodate several requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs could be decorated with drilled holes, could include low backs or gaps for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back could be designed as an included headrest by extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats may be constructed together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is intended to be used as a movable footrest. Every so often the ottoman could be attached to a glider chair with swing arms, allowing the ottoman to rock back and forth along with the glider like a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary textile covers meant for a seat which could offer protection against wear and add attractiveness. A large array of seat covers from neoprene to leather are now available. More formal materials can be rented for occasions like for instance weddings to improve the decor. Some seat covers have decorative seat ties or bows connected to be tied behind the seat in a decorative know or bow.
